# 2008-2009 Season Information

The Season will run from October through to April.

**NOTE: We accept players from 4 to 17 years of age.**  
Depending on the number of registered players, we could have anywhere from 4 to 7 Divisions. No Division will have more than 40 players (10 per team).  
The final decision as to what Division a player will play in, is determined by the Executive Committee.  
Our format to one season. If you wish to register for half a season the cost is \$80.  
"A" Division is for those children aged 4 - 5 years old at time of registration, and therefore not eligible for team play. We will only be able to offer this Level if we have sufficient registration.

*The Adults group may run again if there is sufficient interest. Call the MISL Hotline 860-1440 and ask for details.*

Each team will have a 45-60 minute Practice during the week, Monday-Friday. These are held between 6:15pm and 10:00pm with the younger children taking the earlier time slots. The Practice time and day are consistent for each team from one week to the next.

Games are played on Saturdays between 9:00am and 3:00pm. with the exception of the Level E games which will be played on Tuesday evenings. The game times are consistent for each team from one week to the next, within a 2-hour window, i.e. Level D plays at 9:00am or 10:00am each week etc. The only exception to this will be on weeks that we do not have the facilities on our regular days.

### We need Coaches & Committee Members to help keep this league operating as successfully as it has in previous seasons.

Being a **Coach** requires just a couple of hours a week. No experience is required - this is a non-competitive league with the emphasis placed squarely upon fun, team spirit, and developing the kids both as individuals and team players. A Coaches Clinic and Coaches Manual will be provided.

**Committee Members** are the ones that ensure everything from ordering shirts & balls, organizing the registrations & schedule, referees, etc... the list goes on, runs as smoothly as possible. We are all parent volunteers and must continue to try and improve how this league operates. We cannot do so without your help. There are usually 2 or 3 Committee Meetings during the season, and apart from that it is a pure coordination exercise. If you feel you can help then please consider volunteering.
